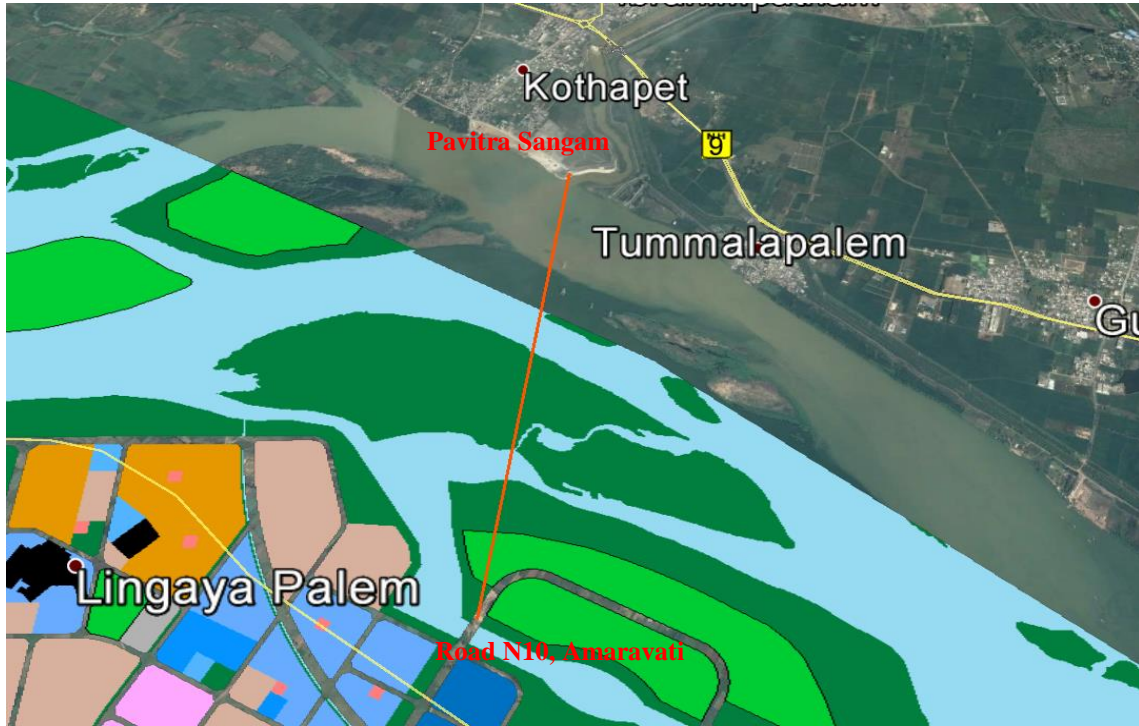

**Expression of Interest (Eoi) for Design and Construction of Iconic Bridge (6 lanes)**  
**on EPC Basis over River Krishna at Amaravati, Capital City of Andhra Pradesh**

Amaravati Development Corporation Limited (ADC) invites Applications for Expression of Interest from experienced firms (Single Entity/Joint Venture) for shortlisting of bidders for **Engineering, Procurement and Construction of 6-lane Iconic Bridge on EPC Basis over River Krishna at Amaravati, Capital City of Andhra Pradesh.**

**Project Brief for Iconic Bridge**

The Iconic bridge as the name suggests, connects both banks of Krishna River and is intended to give identity to the capital city entrance. Unlike many other bridges, the iconic bridge of Amaravati capital city is intended to be aesthetically pleasant to all its users. Function of the bridge that is to facilitate commuters, crossing the Krishna river and providing the connection across both banks of Krishna River has to be fulfilled as well. At the same time, the journey across the vast riverbed and entrance to the upcoming capital city of Andhra Pradesh has to be very pleasant and heart-warming. The bridge need to be seen as welcoming and ceremonial journey to the capital city. The location of the proposed bridge is shown below:



### Location of the proposed Iconic Bridge: Pavitra Sangam to Road N10 in Amaravati

Following are the considerations for the Conceptual Design of the Bridge:

1. The style of the bridge need to reflect the glory and rich cultural heritage of Andhra Pradesh. This bridge may be understood as repositioning of historic sense of aesthetic and culture in the entrance of ultra-modern and aspirational capital city of Andhra Pradesh. The bridge need not necessarily have a look of bridge from past or a pseudo look of historic bridge but need to have elements with definite reference to Andhra Pradesh culture and history.
2. The bridge needs to have an aesthetical theme tying up all the elements of the bridge in following aspects:
  - a. Material

- b. Architectural style – if a theme from historic time has been chosen then all the elements need to reflect same period and same style. Combination of various styles and periods is discouraged. However, a modern interpretation is also welcomed.
  - c. Proportions and scale of various elements
  - d. Iconography – various surfaces if chosen to have various motifs and elements may reflect the art style, proportions, colour and texture of the period and style of architecture chosen for other elements.
  - e. Kuchipudi is an ancient dance form, which has originated from Andhra Pradesh. The designs of the iconic bridge can also be drawn from this dance and its mudras.
3. The overall shape and proportion of the bridge shall be designed keeping in mind following observers
- a. The vehicle commuters – keeping in mind the design speed of the vehicle the details of elements, its frequency and its interval shall be designed,
  - b. Pedestrians – slow paced pedestrian and should be able to stop and enjoy the beauty of the river flowing underneath and the general nature surrounding and the views of the capital city.
  - c. The commuters in the river – the observers commuting in the river may also be able to appreciate the beauty of the bridge. Thus the soffit of the bridge and its support system need to not just functional but also aesthetical pleasant.

4. The Bridge needs to look part of the overall landscape of Krishna River and surroundings
  - a. The Krishna River at this place is very wide and is surrounded by hillocks having height difference of 200-250m from its surrounding flat land. The bridge needs to respond to that in terms of its form.
  - b. The bridge needs to enhance the natural view as seen while crossing the river and should not be an obstruction for enjoying the view.
  - c. All the elements functional and aesthetical need to design keeping in mind the background i.e. hillocks, river, and other elements of nature like background of sky and clouds.
  - d. The construction of the bridge and its operation and maintenance should also protect and enhance the landscape settings and should not destroy it.
5. Firms shall prepare conceptual designs for the following two categories:
  - a. **Category 1: Conventional Arrangement with a grand entry and exit:**

A conventional bridge with grand entry and exits. The proposed Bridge on River Krishna shall act as a gateway to Amaravati. The architectural designs for the entry and exit shall reflect culture and heritage of Andhra Pradesh.
  - b. **Category 2: Cable supported Bridge:**

A cable supported (Extradosed/ Cable Stayed/Tied Arch/Suspension) Bridge that reflects culture and prominence of Andhra Pradesh in the structural configuration (along with high tensioned cable stay supports) of the Bridge.

Culture and prominence of Andhra Pradesh shall be reflected through aesthetic view of Pylons or the suitable deck supported arrangements.

6. The firm shall be required to provide design details as required by ADC for architectural envelope of the bridge for the above two categories, including structural and implementation feasibility in relation to the urban design and architectural guidelines of the Amaravati Capital City.
  - a. The scope of work shall include but not limited to planning and design for architectural, structural engineering, MEP, Safety, Acoustics, Lighting, Signage, and Landscape etc.
  - b. Conceptual Design:
    - i. Develop a vision for the project, translation of vision in to design brief
    - ii. Preparation of detailed design brief
    - iii. Preparation of conceptual design
    - iv. Architectural and engineering concepts (Structure, MEP & ELV components)
    - v. Urban Design aspects
    - vi. Safety and security features

## **Selection Process**

1. Firms are advised that the shortlisting of the firms shall be on the basis of the evaluation of the submitted technical and financial documentation submitted by the applicants. Applicants shall be deemed to have understood and agreed that no explanation or justification for any aspect of the Selection Process will be given and that the Client's decisions are final.
2. Please note that **RFP will only** be issued to the shortlisted firms in the Expression of Interest (Eoi) process. Submission of the Designs for the proposed bridge (for both conventional bridge and Cable stayed bridge) is mandatory to fulfil the requirements to participate in Eoi process.
3. In the **first stage** of shortlisting process, the architectural conceptual designs submitted by the EOI applicants and architectural firms and colleges invited by the ADC for the project would be opened. The Client shall appoint a jury of comprising of eminent professional of repute for examining and recommending the submitted Concept Designs. The discretion of the jury shall be final and binding on all the participants. The jury shall recommend **five designs for each category** for further evaluation by the Competent Authority. The Competent Authority would **select one design in each category** for further necessary action.
4. In the **second stage**, Request for Proposal (RFP) for Design and Construction of Iconic Bridge (with final conceptual design) on EPC mode would be invited.
5. The Client reserves the right to verify all statements, information and documents, submitted by the Applicant in response to the Eoi. Any such verification or the

lack of such verification by the Client to undertake such verification shall not relieve the Applicant of its obligations or liabilities hereunder; nor will it affect any rights of the Client thereunder.

6. Any information contained in the proposal shall not in any way be construed as binding on the Client, its agents, successors or assigns, but shall be binding against the Applicant if the Contract is subsequently awarded to it.
